## Policy: Accident Reporting and Investigation

## **Policy Statement**

The Manurewa High School Board of Trustees recognises its responsibility to report all accidents and incidents involving harm to persons and this will be investigated in order to prevent a reoccurrence of similar accidents. Deficiencies will be identified and any remedial action will be implemented.

## **Procedural Guidelines**

- All work related injuries will be recorded in the approved register which is held in the Health Centre.
- Potential accidents and/or 'near misses' are to be recorded in the approved register.
- Accidents/incidences involving serious harm will follow OSH reporting systems and procedures.
- Investigations will determine course, consequences and develop controls to minimise and eliminate risk of recurrence.
- Investigations at all times will demonstrate concern for employees and student well-being.
- Staff will be informed of requirements regarding accidents/incidences/'near misses' reporting.
