All children and young people need to have ongoing, systematic and appropriate assessment which provides a range of data to inform programme planning and decision-making.

Procedural Guidelines

- Specialists competence is maintained and enhanced through induction
- Specialists competence is maintained and enhanced through professional development*
- Specialists competence is maintained and enhanced through performance management
- Specialists competence is maintained and enhanced through professional supervision and support
- Assessment tools are current, evidence-based, appropriate for the New Zealand context and assessment purpose, and meet current practice standards for the relevant professional body
- Assessment practice is culturally responsive and competent
- Workload management procedures are documented.
