

Kia Ora Students & Whaanau

As you will already be aware the government announced this afternoon that there are further community COVID-19 cases in Aotearoa, New Zealand, especially in Auckland, meaning Auckland will remain in Alert Level 4 up until at least midnight on Tuesday 31st August with a further update on Monday 30th August. **Therefore, school will continue to remain closed for all students.**

A reminder that for all students with devices work will continue to be up on Schoology from 10am every morning and if your teacher is doing a live lesson it will only be during your timetabled akoranga block. 
