As you will already be aware the government announced today that Auckland will remain in Alert Level 3 Phase 1 and a return to school has been delayed with further information to be given next Monday. **Therefore, from the start of Term 4 Monday 18th October school will remain closed for all students** apart from those of essential workers under 14 years of age who have no other whaanau available to look after them.

Please arrive at school at 9am **starting from Monday 18th October with your device fully charged.** You will undergo a health check and then be placed in a bubble of 10 students maximum and 2 support staff members to continue your online work for the day. **All students and staff will be required to wear a mask** and we will have spare masks if you need one.
