




If you are a Year 11, 12 or 13 History student who would like extra help on the topics you've been studying in History or some extra time and/or assistance with your History internals, this is for you.

Would you like to use your Waananga time to work on assessments and class work?


Then this is the Waananga is for you.

If you choose this Waananga we will be in touch to go through the application process with you











The choir performs in performing arts evenings, public and community events, and school prize giving's at the end of the







Young Enterprise YESWS


The Young Enterprise Scheme (YES) is a national high school business enterprise competition with over \$20k in prize money, scholarships and overseas trips.


