When choosing your subjects, remember to think about your interests, abilities, and how useful the subject might be for your future.

It is helpful to choose an option that you have taken in Year 9 and that you would like to continue with in Year 11.

Please note you cannot take all courses together, there are some exclusions to be aware of. Please see below

 The Year 10 Japanese class is a full year course that will cover a range of topics including talking about your family, Japanese food, likes and dislikes, where you are from, school life and much more




What will I learn?

COURSE OUTLINE

This course caters to beginnerlevel students who have a keen interest in learning about the Tongan culture and language. Emphasis is placed on the ability to speak clearly, read, write and understand the Tongan language both formal and informal. Communication is the main goal, written assessments and work will show skills covered orally with regular assessments on conversations, presentations and writing. A number of new resources will be used to familiarise you with Tongan culture through readings, discussions, research and visitations.

Tongan is a unique language and culture. The Tongan community is one of the largest Pacific nations in New Zealand and one of the most spoken Pacific languages in New Zealand. There is no doubt that the Tongan people standout in Auckland especially during times of celebration particularly Rugby and Rugby league games.





Why learn the Māori Language here at Te Kura Tuarua o Manurewa?

Learning Te Reo Māori at Te Kura Tuarua o Manurewa fosters cultural appreciation and inclusivity deepens understanding of the heritage of Aotearoa, and strengthens community connections. It enriches students' education, enhances personal growth, and supports career opportunities while preserving an essential part of the nation's cultural landscape.

The Year 10 Te Reo Māori language and cultural course at Manurewa High School builds on the foundations laid in Year 9. Students will advance their proficiency in speaking, reading, and writing Te Reo Māori, focusing on more complex sentence structures and vocabulary. The course also delves deeper into Māori customs, traditions, and values, exploring significant historical events and contemporary issues. Interactive activities, such as kapa haka (performing arts) and marae visits, enhance cultural understanding and engagement. The course aims to foster a greater appreciation of Māori culture and language, preparing students for further study and community involvement.



















Course Name Design Visual Communication Course Code 10DVC
