

2025 Course Information Year 13

General Information



Level 3 students should have a future pathway in mind and an idea of where they want to go when they leave school. For example, a university/tertiary course, apprenticeship training, or straight into paid employment. Make sure that the courses you choose allow you to get to where you want to go next.

Students should ideally take five University Entrance (UE) approved subjects if they are considering going to university, particularly the University of Auckland.

Level 3 NCEA courses are made up of both internal and external assessments.

In some cases, where students in Year 13 have not yet achieved Level 2 NCEA, they may decide to study a combination of Level 2 courses to complete this certificate and Level 3 courses so that they also work towards achieving Level 3 NCEA. There is also an opportunity to study a course that will offer a combination of Level 2 and 3 credits.

Please choose **FIVE** courses and **ONE** alternative (back-up) course. In Year 13, there are no compulsory subjects, and you can choose any 5 courses you would like to do.

Please note you cannot take all the courses and there are some exclusions to be aware of. Please see below for the exclusions for Level 3 courses.

Scholarship Exams: A separate Scholarship exam will be offered for students to sit if they desire in a range of learning areas. Speak with your subject teacher for further information.

Note: For entry requirements for specific tertiary providers (i.e universities, AUT, MIT, etc.) please check with Pathways.

National Certificate of Educational Achievement - Level 3

To gain NCEA Level 3 students need to gain the following:

- 60 credits at Level 3,
- 20 credits at Level 2 or higher,
- 10 Literacy or Te Reo Matatini credits, and
- 10 Numeracy or Te Pāngarau credits

Level Endorsement:

- Merit Endorsement: Obtained if 50 Merit and/or Excellence credits are achieved.
- **Excellence Endorsement:** Obtained if 50 Excellence credits are achieved.

Course Endorsements:

- Merit Endorsement: 14 credits (at least 3 credits from an external) at Merit or Excellence.
- **Excellence Endorsement:**14 credits (at least 3 credits from an external) at Excellence.

University Entrance Requirements:

Students will need **ALL** of the following to be awarded University Entrance:

- Attain NCEA Level 3
- Achieve **14 credits** at Level 3 in **each** of at least of **three** courses from the list of approved courses. The list of approved courses will consist of courses derived from the New Zealand Curriculum with achievement standards at Level 3.
- Achieve **UE Numeracy** 10 credits at Level 1 or higher from specific achievement standards, or three specific numeracy unit standards.
- Achieve **UE Literacy** 10 credits (five in reading and five in writing) at Level 2 or above from specific standards.
