At Year 9 all students will participate in the following courses: English, Mathematics, Science, Social Studies, Health & Physical Education, Te Reo Maaori, Technology, and Aotearoa New Zealand Histories.

To supplement these compulsory subjects, students must also choose **THREE** other options: **TWO** arts options and **ONE** language option.

Please ensure you select **TWO** from: 09ART (Art Practical), 09DAN (Dance), 09DRA (Drama), 09MUS (Music), or 09MUO (Music Academy).

Please select **ONE** from: 09DGT (Digital Technology), 09JAP (Japanese), 09SAM (Samoan), 09SPA (Spanish), or 09TON (Tongan).

When choosing your subjects, remember to think about your interests, abilities, and how useful the subject might be for your future.

They are organised according to Learning Areas.

Students choose **TWO** from the blue highlighted courses – they will do these courses for two terms each.

Why learn the Māori Language here at Te Kura Tuarua o Manurewa?

Learning Te Reo Māori at Te Kura Tuarua o Manurewa fosters cultural appreciation and inclusivity deepens understanding of the heritage of Aotearoa, and strengthens community connections. It enriches students' education, enhances personal growth, and supports career opportunities while preserving an essential part of the nation's cultural landscape. It is encouraged that students experience kapa haka.

The Year 9 Te Reo Māori language and cultural course at Te Kura Tuarua o Manurewa introduces students to the basics of the Māori language, including pronunciation, greetings, and everyday vocabulary. Students will explore Māori customs, traditions, and values, learning about significant cultural practices and their historical contexts. The course includes activities such as waiata (songs), haka (traditional dance), and basic conversational exercises, providing a well-rounded foundation in both language and culture.





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
